The EU-funded project, POWERPOOR in a nutshell

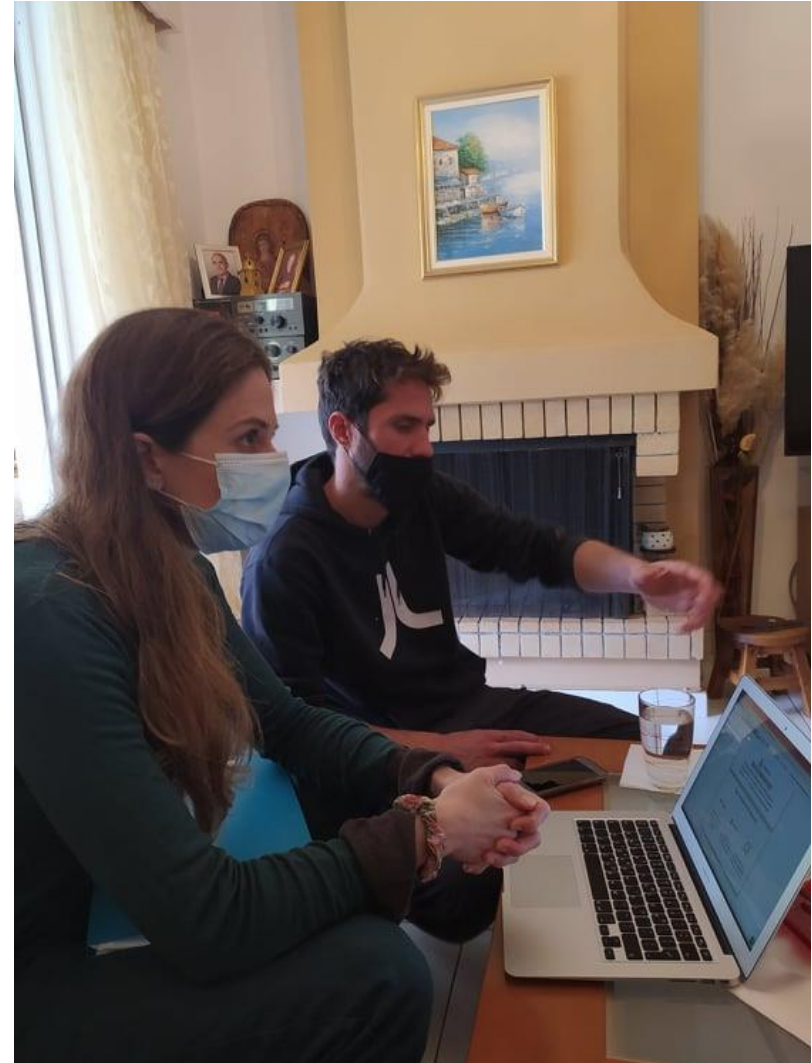

- Pilot energy poor support programmes in Bulgaria, Croatia, **Estonia (EKYL)**, Greece, Hungary, Latvia, Portugal & Spain led by a network of **certified Energy Supporters & Mentors** who accompany impacted households to participate in joint energy initiatives & draw their attention to changing consumer habits.



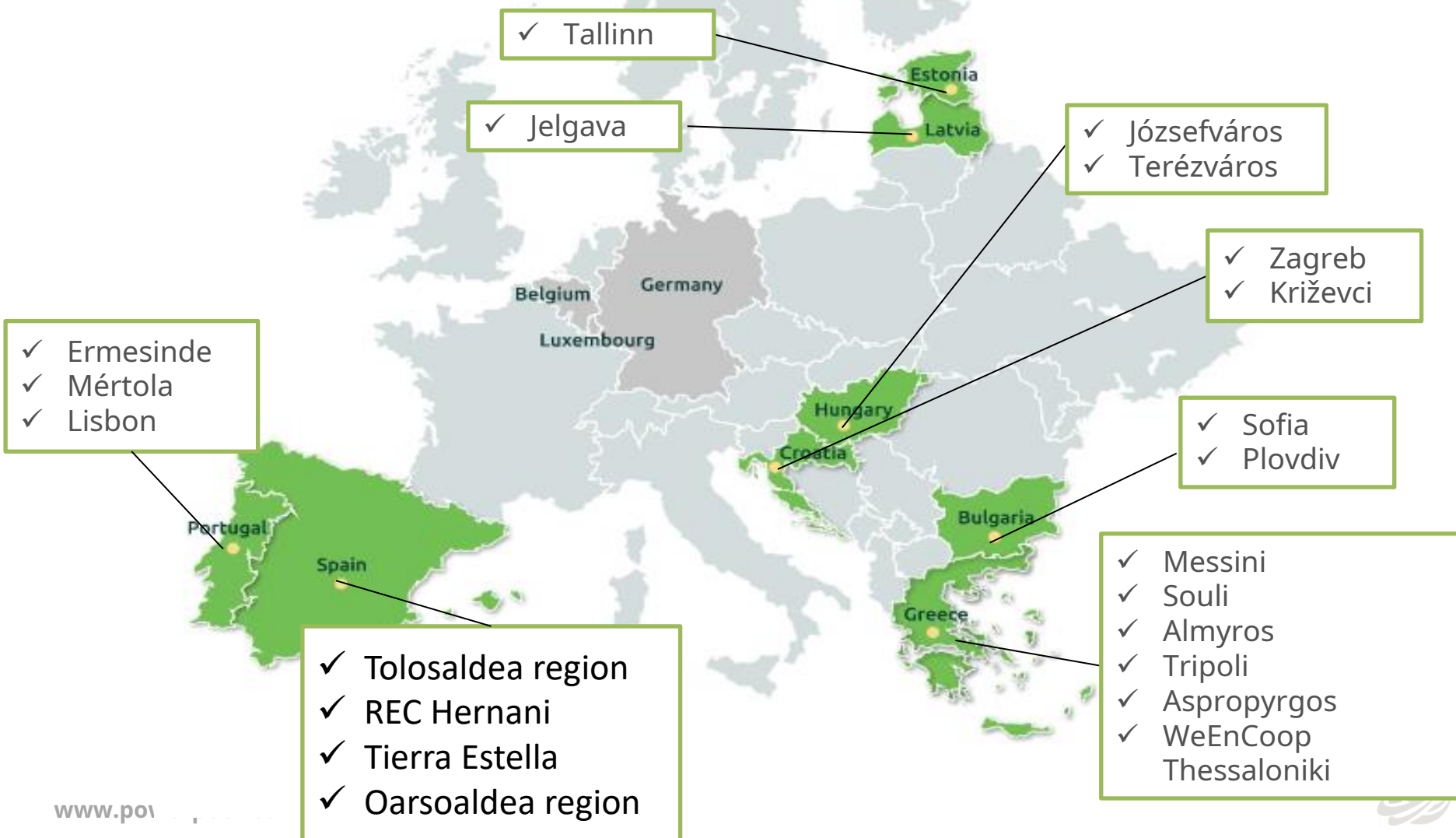

Tackling energy poverty in Sustainable Energy and Climate Action Plan (SECAP)

An integrated approach based on qualitative and quantitative information could be developed by:

1. Assessing the municipality's vulnerability to energy poverty;
2. Identifying the specific households suffering from energy poverty;
3. Choosing and customising tools that are tailored to the local context to tackle the issue
