



Installation Instructions

1. The user should install **Docker**. You may download Docker [here](#).
2. Once the Docker is installed and running, open **PowerShell/Command Prompt** (Windows user) or open **Terminal** (Mac and Ubuntu users).
3. Execute the following command:

```
docker run --rm -d --publish 1313:8000 socialwatt/socialwatt_analyser:latest
```

Once the command is successfully executed, the user should get the following screen:

```
> docker run --rm -d --publish 1313:8000 socialwatt/socialwatt_analyser:latest

Important note: Port 1313 can be any port the user prefers.

4. Once the previous screen appears, the user should open the browser and paste the link: <http://localhost:1313/>
5. The user should be able to access the SocialWatt Analyser application.

In order to re-access the SocialWatt Analyser, docker should be running and the link <http://localhost:1313/> will direct the user to SocialWatt Analyser.

Finally, when a new version of the tool is available, the user should follow the next steps:

1. Execute the command **docker ps -a** in the PowerShell/command prompt or terminal
2. Identify the **CONTAINER ID**. It should be found by the name **socialwatt/socialwatt_analyser:latest**
3. In case there is no container ID with this name, execute the following command:

```
docker rmi socialwatt/socialwatt_analyser:latest
```



4. Stop the container by executing the following command:

docker stop <CONTAINER ID>

5. Delete the old version of SocialWatt Analyser by executing the following command:

docker rmi socialwatt/socialwatt_analyser:latest

6. Install the latest version of SocialWatt Analyser by following the abovementioned steps, starting from Step 3.
